- Organizes and maintains a system for accurate and complete record-keeping, grading, reporting, achievement and attendance as required by district procedures and applicable laws.
- Encourages parental involvement in students' education and ensures effective communication with students and parents.
- Ensures that student conduct conforms with the school's standards and school district policies and establishes and maintains standards of pupil behavior needed to achieve a functional learning atmosphere in the classroom.
- Coordinates with other staff members, especially within grade level and specific subjects, to evaluate and assess curriculum, and participates in faculty meetings.
- Administers standardized tests in accordance with district testing programs.
